Come Wine with Us (registered as Come Join Us) was a marketing and promotional events platform designed to connect food, drink, products, and new potential clients in a unique and engaging way.

Unlike traditional food and wine pairings, our events were hosted at selected restaurants or venues, which were encouraged to showcase their menus or special offerings to foster repeat patronage.

Participating wine estates and other beverage brands – including brandy, whisky, beer, and vodka – were invited to promote their products through curated tastings, paired with dishes either prepared by the restaurant or by our clients.

The company successfully operated for eight years, with events fully booked up to two years in advance and a database of over 4,500 members. Our

primary clients included Distell's premium wine and whisky brands such as Zonnebloem, Nederburg, Plaisir de Merle, Durbanville Hills, Alto, Fleur du Cap, Amarula, Scottish Leader, Three Ships Premium Whisky, and Bain's Whisky.
